



FISI and Sci Club Eur in cooperation with 5 Cime Sci Club are pleased to invite all ski nations to attend the **FIS Freestyle Europa Cup** to be held in Piancavallo ski area, Friuli Venezia Giulia region, Italy. The competition will be run in accordance to the International Ski Competition Rules (ICR). All national associations affiliated to the FIS are invited to compete.

Rules

- 1 Sci Club Eur, 5 Cime Sci Club and the Federazione Italiana Sport Invernali (FISI) are organizing an event of the FIS Freestyle Europa Cup.
- 2 The dates for this event have been published in the FIS calendar 2012/2013.
- 3 The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing. Protest should be submitted to the jury up to 15 minutes after the end of the competition, according to the FIS rules.
- 4 The competition is composed of two (2) Moguls events, for both women and men.
- 5 In accordance with FIS ICR, the competition will follow an official program, which will be available to all participants. The program will include qualifications and finals for the event of Moguls for men and women.
- 6 The competition will take place on 15 and 16 February 2013 in Piancavallo, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Italy.
- 7 If necessary, the organising committee and the Federazione Italiana Sport Invernali, subject to the approval of the FIS, reserve the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the program.

Entries

Entries (including also the names of the officials, as well as the competitors) will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with FIS quotas and rules and must be submitted to the organizing committee **by 5 February 2013**. Complete early entries are welcome.

Entries must be sent to the organising committee exclusively by email to Info@SciClubEur.org.

The final entries of the competitors, with full data, must be provided by the team coach to the administration office no later than two (2) hours before the draw for each competition, as per FIS Rule No. 217.1.

All the athletes must be in the FIS lists.

Entry Fee

The entry fee of the Europa Cup is 41,00 € per competitor per event and must be paid in cash.

Liability

Skipass

Free skipasses are available for competitors, coaches and team captains from Thursday 14 February till Saturday 16 February (official training and competition days). For others training days a special price will be applied.

Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competitions and prize-giving ceremonies. A deposit of 15 € each is requested for collecting bibs.

Accident Insurance

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The organizing committee, the sponsors and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and third part claims during the events.

Accommodation / Food

Accommodation will be provided at the Hotel Villa Policreti, Via IV Novembre 13, 33081 Castel d'Aviano, Aviano (PN) that is about 20 minutes from Piancavallo. The organizing committee will take care of the reservations only for the teams that will make an explicit request.

The requests have to indicate the number of persons and rooms and the arrival and departure dates and must be addressed to the Hotel Villa Policreti, fax +39 0434677169, email info@villapolicreti.net.

The Hotel Villa Policreti offers to all the team members a special rate of 65,00 € per day in full board with lunch on the slopes (close to the finish area) and dinner at the hotel.

Location

By car from Trieste or Udine on the A4 highway, once arrived to Portogruaro, follow the directions to Pordenone on the A28 highway, then proceed for 30 km following the directions to Aviano and Piancavallo.

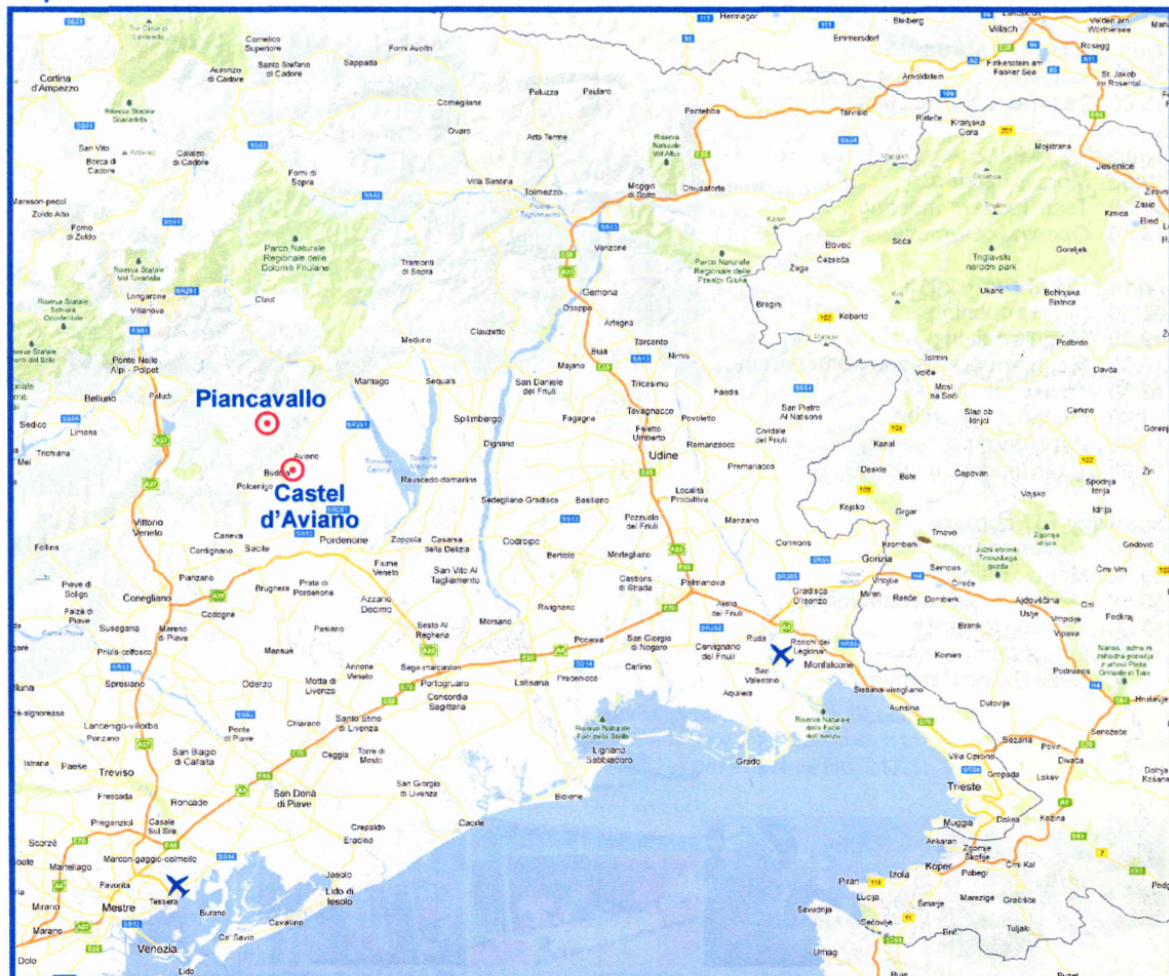
